

**Note:-**

- ❖ The candidates not having the prescribed qualifications shall not be eligible for appearing TNTET.
- ❖ A person who is pursuing any of the teacher education courses (recognized by the NCTE or the RCI, as the case may be) specified in the NCTE Notification amended from time to time shall be eligible for appearing in the TET.
- ❖ The candidates should satisfy their eligibility before applying. They should be personally responsible in case they are not eligible to apply as per the eligibility criteria. It is to be noted that, if a candidate has been allowed to appear for TET, it does not imply that the eligibility of the candidate has been verified. It does not vest any right to appointment of the candidate after passing the examination.

**Note:-**

- a. **Child Development and pedagogy** will focus on Educational Psychology of Teaching and Learning, relevant to the age group of 6 – 11 years.
- b. **Language I** will focus on the proficiencies related to the Medium of Instruction. The candidate has to choose any one of the languages mentioned in Sl.No.(ii) above in Paper-I table. For recruitment process candidates shall be eligible for the vacancies in the concerned medium only
- c. **Language II English** will focus on the elements of language, communication and comprehension abilities.
- d. **Mathematics and Environmental Studies** will focus on the concepts, problem solving abilities and pedagogical understanding of these subjects.
- e. The questions in the TET Paper I will be based on the topics of the prescribed syllabus of the State for Classes I – V **but their difficulty level as well as linkages will be up to the Secondary Stage.**

- a. **Child Development and Pedagogy** will focus on Educational Psychology of Teaching and Learning, relevant to the age group of 11-14 Years.
- b. **Language-I** will focus on the proficiencies related to the medium of instruction. The candidate has to choose any one of the languages mentioned in Sl. No.(ii) above in Paper II table. For recruitment process, candidate shall be considered for the vacancies in the concerned medium only.
- c. **Language II - English** will focus on the elements of language, communication and comprehension abilities.
- d. **Mathematics and Science / Social Science** will focus on the concepts. Problem solving abilities and pedagogical understanding of these subjects.
- e. The questions in the test Paper-II will be based on the topics of the prescribed syllabus of the State for Classes VI-VIII but **their difficulty level as well as linkages will be up to the Senior Secondary (Higher Secondary ) Stage.**

**4. Procedure to Apply:**

- a) Candidates should apply only through online mode in the TRB website <http://www.trb.tn.nic.in>
- b) Use separate application for Paper-I and Paper-II.
- c) Candidates should ensure that they have their scanned recent color passport size photograph (JPG/JPEG /PNG format of size 20-60 kB) and signature (JPG/JPEG/PNG format of size 10-30 kB) separately. The online application uploaded without the photograph and signature will be rejected.
- d) A valid e-mail id and Mobile Number are mandatory for registration and e-mail id should be kept active till the declaration of results.
