2. ELIGIBILTY CRITERIA

- I. The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- II. The educational qualification, age, experience, etc as stipulated in the advertisement shall be determined as on the closing date of submission of application.
- III. Post Code 61/20, 62/20 and 63/20: Vacancy for APST is reserved only for APST candidates who are domicile of the respective districts of Tirap, Longding and Changlang. The APST candidates applying in a particular district must be permanent resident of the district concerned. The posts of General will be only for the General candidates who are domicile of the respective districts of Tirap, Longding and Changlang. The candidates should possess Temporary Residential Certificate or Permanent Residential Certificate or Class-X pass Certificate from recognized education institution of the districts (Tirap, Longding and Changlang) where he/she has applied for the post.

Stage-I

Physical standard Test (PST), Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Trade Test:

- (i) Physical standard Test (PST) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET) shall be carried out at the designated recruitment centre which will be intimated through call letter and APSSB website. List of accepted/rejected candidates and date & time for PST/PET will be uploaded in APSSB website at www.apssb.in
- (ii) PET and PST will be of qualifying nature only.
- (iii) Candidates will have to qualify in the PST and PET to be able to appear for subsequent stages.

Stage-II (only for Post code 67/20, 70/20 and 71/20)

<u>Trade Test</u>: The applicants for the post of Constable (Band/Bugler) IRBn (Male), H/C Driver and Constable Driver (Civil Police) who qualify the PST/PET will have to undergo a Trade Test, carrying 100 Marks.

- The test will comprise of the following subjects:-
- a) General English 100 marks

<u>Syllabus:-</u> In addition to testing of candidate's understanding and comprehension of the English Language, questions On its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc would also be covered.

b) Elementary Math - 100 marks

<u>Syllabus:-</u> The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities will cover number systems including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Data Interpretations, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit and Loss, Discount, Simple and Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time And Work, Time and Distance, Tables and Graphs etc.

c) General Knowledge - 100 marks

<u>Syllabus:-</u> Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidates General Knowledge of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The Test will also include questions relating to History, Polity, Constitution, Sports, Art and Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific Research, National/International Organizations/Institutions etc. State specific questions may also be asked.

d) Theoretical Paper – 100 marks

Syllabus:- Details of syllabus etc shall be informed at a later date through the official website.

- Each question shall carry 02(two) marks. There will be a negative marking of 1/4 for incorrect answer (i.e. 1/4 of 2 = 0.5 marks).
- A candidate must secure a minimum of 33% or more marks in each subject in the written examination paper and must secure 45% of marks out of aggregate total marks in the written examination paper. In other words selection in third stage will be based on the aggregate total marks secured in the written examination paper. The candidate securing less than 33% of marks in any of the subject shall be deemed not eligible.
- The final merit for 67/20, 70/20 and 71/20 shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured in stage 2 and stage 3. The final merit for 58/20, 59/20, 60/20, 61/20, 62/20, 63/20, 64/20, 65/20, 66/20, 68/20, 69/20 shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured in stage 3 only.
