(i) Syllabus of Main (Written) Examination:-

Paper-I (Composite Paper)-General English, Odia Language & General Studies

The questions of General English (GE) & Odia Language (OL) will be of HSC standard and will comprise of comprehension of given passage, vocabulary & usage of grammar.

The questions of General Studies paper will comprise of questions on Indian History & History of Odisha, Geography of the world and of India, Indian polity, Environmental studies, Human Rights, Socio Economic Development, Art, Culture & General Science. The question of



GA is of HSC standard. **There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer in Composite Paper.**

Paper-II (Technical Paper):

The questions of Technical Paper will comprise of questions on Basic knowledge in Engineering and entrepreneurship against management, concept prescribed for 1st & 2nd semester course under BPUT for Degree/Diploma Engineers such as Physics, Chemistry, Mechanics, Basic Electronics, Basic Electrical Engineering, Thermodynamics, entrepreneurship & Industrial & Personal Management. **There will be negative marking of 0.5 marks for each wrong answer in Technical Paper.**

(ii) Document verification & Viva-voce Test

Candidates three times of the vacancies in order of merit category wise basing on the marks secured in the main written examination shall be shortlisted to appear in Viva Voce Test.

The certificate verification of the candidates with relation to Educational qualification, Age, Caste, Special Category will be done before Viva Voce Test on the same date. The candidates will be required to produce their original Academic Certificates, Mark sheets and other required documents as per clause-7 of this advertisement along with a set of self attested photocopy of the same and OSSC copy of the application duly signed by the applicant for verification.

09. PLACE AND DATE OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

The Date/Time/ Venue of the Written Examination will be informed to the eligible candidates in their Admission Letters, in due course.
